 Our Community (Summit Lake Neighborhood) – South Street Ministries serves in the Summit Lake community, one of South Street's primary ministries is youth engagement and development. RICH KIDS, Bike Shop, and Open Gym all work with Summit Lake youth in Summit Lake.

Summit Lake History

- The Summit Lake neighborhood was historically Akron's playground during the rubber boom. Over time disinvestment and decline saw the community shift into statistically the highest crime and poverty neighborhood of Akron in the latter 1990's, when South Street was founded. Over the next few decades, houses were demolished and Summit Lake presently hosts the highest concentration of abandoned and vacant properties in Summit County.
- There has always been a strong network of neighbors and residents who have fought, served, and advocated for the community's good. Presently, Summit Lake has seen investment along the Towpath and is investigating further development into the core of the neighborhood. Along with these developments the crime rate is decreasing in the Summit Lake neighborhood.
- Discipleship House Fellows will embark on a journey of learning how to seek justice and love our neighbors within the Summit Lake Community.

Engagement & Service

- Ministry Time Requirements
 - 20 Hours of weekly ministry work
 - You will be placed in areas within South Street Ministries and/or approved partners in Summit Lake based on your passions, strengths & areas of interest.
 - Youth Programming
 - Reentry and/or Recovery
 - Non-Profit // Administrative Work
- Community Engagement Time Requirements

- 10 Hours of monthly community events & non-programmatic relational time
 - We will have times when we are not in a programmatic space, but are
 intentionally engaging in relationship with our community. Connecting and
 building relationships within the community, outside of programmatic space, is
 an essential aspect of the overall experience.
 - 10 Hours is the monthly requirement, however, we welcome, and encourage much of this, as this will embody the life on life interactions we desire you to step towards during the DHF.

Community Living

Covenant Together –

- House Values, Rhythms, Expectations, & Approaches
 - This will be created by and with the Fellows.

DH Visitors

We desire the DH to be a place where the community is welcomed in and invited into spaces where life and ministry is happening. Community living takes compromise and understanding, so visitors guidelines will be created and molded alongside the Fellows in the House Covenant.

Dating Relationships

We will have both males and females participating in the DHF. We expect that there would be no inter Fellow dating while in the program.

Church Connection –

- As a part of the DHF, Fellows will be asked to be engaged in the Front Porch Fellowship on Sunday Mornings from 11 am to 1 pm.
 - An essential aspect of the Fellowship is that we live, work, minister, and worship in the community that we live in.

Costs

- All housing costs will be covered
- Food Weekly Collective Grocery Allowance
- Stipend Monthly Allocation (up to \$250)

Outside Work or School

The program is designed to give you the space to step towards part time work outside of the DHF, or to work in conjunction with students in college. We encourage part time work to be scheduled outside of regular DHF meetings and service times. Work schedules should be discussed with the DHF leaders in advance.

An Invitation to Support SSM

- The Discipleship House Fellowship desires to support those participating in the DHF through covering the costs of Housing, providing a Collective House Grocery Allowance, as well as giving Fellows a Monthly Stipend. The DHF desires that this support allows participants to fully give themselves to the experience of the DHF, committing time and effort into the vast array of service and learning that will occur in the Fellowship. This is made possible through the support of South Street Ministries.
- We hope the support provided allows for this journey of discipleship to be accessible to individuals beyond their financial state. With that, the DHF welcomes and asks Fellows to invite those in their networks to support this opportunity being made possible by financially supporting South Street Ministries.

Vacation & Holidays

- Holidays
 - Thanksgiving
 - November 27 December 1 OFF
 - Christmas & New Year's
 - December 21st January 5th OFF
- Vacation (Applicants can request additional approval for known scheduling conflicts prior to starting the program)
 - 7 Days of Vacation personally allocated.
 - Request vacation days 2 weeks prior to a DHF leader for approval.

Retreat Days

- Retreat Day is a day of intentional rest, spent removing oneself from their everyday tasks and spending time in prayer, in the word, reflecting, and simply spending time with the Lord.
 - One retreat day should be taken during each quarter.

• Alcohol, Tobacco, Marijuana, Illegal Drugs & Weapons

- Alcohol free-space This is not in place because we believe alcohol itself is sinful, however we
 do not want it to be a distraction during your year of the DHF. We hope to be a space where we
 are witnesses at all times and that our community and youth can always be welcomed into our
 home.
- o Substance use not permitted; Tobacco, Marijuana & Vaping.
- o Lethal weapons not permitted on the DHF property.
