Walking Together in Restoration and Renewal

Every number represents a life touched, a need met, and our South Akron and Summit Lake community strengthened. From mentoring youth through RICH Kids, Bike Shop, and Open Gym to walking alongside justice-impacted individuals through Reentry Services, Restoration House, and Youth Violence Intervention & Mentoring, South Street Ministries is committed to showing up where it matters most.

This year, we also provided essential resources through Thanksgiving Baskets and the Christmas Store, ensuring families could celebrate with dignity. Our community gatherings—like the MLK Day Back-to-School Winter Blast (**distributing 130+ coats and 100 backpacks**) and the Day of Change Reentry Fair, each drawing **over 150 attendees**—fostered connection, hope, and opportunity.

And beyond these measurable moments, countless small acts of kindness—like providing **birth certificates (245)** and **beds and shoes to 93 individuals**—continue to make a difference in everyday lives. Together, we are serving our neighbors – walking alongside them in restoration and renewal.

A Season of Transformation Through Transportation

Access to reliable transportation is a critical step toward stability and independence. This year, South Street Ministries has helped justice-impacted adults and youth move from unemployment to opportunity – connecting 100+ individuals to jobs, interviews, and essential resources. Through bus passes, fare assistance, rides to the transit center, and even bikes, we've empowered individuals to take tangible steps toward rebuilding their lives, supporting their families, and contributing to their communities.

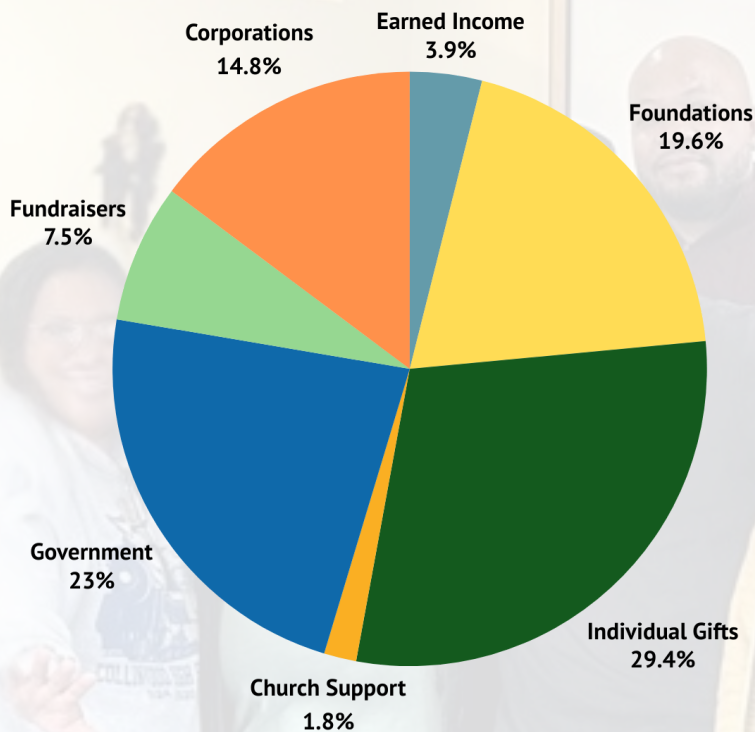
